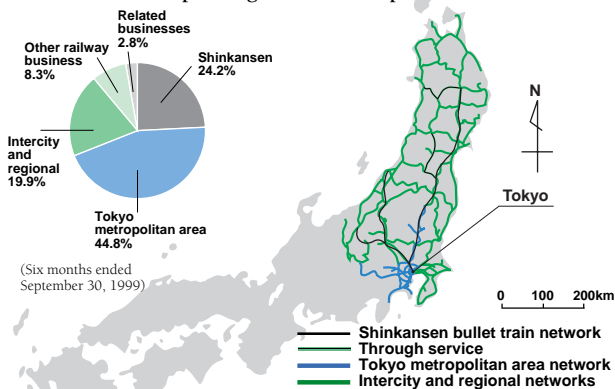


JR East in Profile and Corporate Data

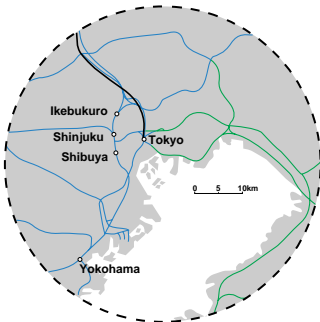
Nonconsolidated Operating Revenue Composition
